| Position Description | <p>The Mindsets & Motivation Lab at Yale-NUS College seeks a post-Ph.D. scholar with training in social/personality psychology, educational psychology, or a related discipline. The project involves developing a psychological intervention to promote a growth mindset of interest among students and examining outcomes on academic achievement, motivation, innovation, and interest.</p> <p>Responsibilities include designing and conducting longitudinal field studies, plus lab experiments, training and managing research assistants, data analysis, writing manuscripts, and writing follow-up grant proposals.</p> <p>The fellowship is a 2-year position funded by a grant from the Ministry of Education beginning in January or February 2017. The Fellow will receive a 12-month salary plus benefits based on experience and qualifications. Furthermore, the fellow will be based in Singapore and will work closely with Principle Investigator, Dr. Paul A. O’Keefe (Yale-NUS College), as well as collaborators at Stanford University (Drs. Carol S. Dweck and Gregory M. Walton).</p> |
