<b>Position Description</b>	<p>Yale-NUS College, a collaboration between the National University of Singapore and Yale University, invites applicants for a tenure track position at the Assistant Professor rank in the interdisciplinary area of Urban Studies.</p> <p>Applications are welcome from any relevant social or spatial discipline. An interest in Asian urbanism or cities in a comparative perspective is desirable, but not necessary.</p> <p>Applicants should have a relevant PhD and be active researchers with a commitment to creative and effective undergraduate teaching and mentoring. The incoming faculty member would join a committed team dedicated to the development and teaching of the Urban Studies Major (see <a href="https://urbanstudies.yale-nus.edu.sg/">https://urbanstudies.yale-nus.edu.sg/</a>) and Yale-NUS's flagship Common Curriculum (see <a href="https://www.yale-nus.edu.sg/curriculum/common-curriculum/">https://www.yale-nus.edu.sg/curriculum/common-curriculum/</a>).</p> <p>The appointee will be expected to begin their duties in time for the start of the 2018-2019 academic year.
