<b>Position Description</b>	<p>Yale-NUS College, a collaboration between the National University of Singapore and Yale University, invites applications for an open rank, tenured or tenure-track faculty position in Psychology. We seek outstanding applicants in any field of Psychology.</p> <p>Applicants should have a PhD in Psychology and be active researchers with a commitment to creative and effective undergraduate teaching and mentoring. The incoming faculty member would join a committed team dedicated to the development and teaching of the Psychology major and Yale-NUS's flagship Common Curriculum (see <a href="http://www.yale-nus.edu.sg/curriculum/common-curriculum">http://www.yale-nus.edu.sg/curriculum/common-curriculum</a>).</p> <p>The appointee will be expected to begin duties in time for the start of the 2019-2020 academic year. Salary, benefits, and leave policies are competitive with those at an international level. Yale-NUS College is committed to supporting faculty research through start-up grants, travel allowances, study leave, research support and institutional assistance with proposal preparation and administration of external grant funding.</p>
<b>Application Procedure</b>	<p>Applications should comprise the following: a cover letter explaining why the position at Yale-NUS is of interest; a full <i>curriculum vitae</i>, including a complete list of publications; statements on a) research interests, b) teaching experience, and c) teaching philosophy, including how these might fit with the College's particular mission and curriculum; teaching evaluations (if available), and other relevant documents. For the tenured position, applicants are required to provide names and contact information of three (3) academic referees.</p> <p>Review of complete applications will begin October 31, 2018 and continue until the position is filled.
